**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1306, as introduced, creates the Oklahoma Livestock Care Standards Board under the auspices of the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. According to officials at the Department, the costs associated with setting up the Board, writing the rules and paying travel reimbursement is as follows:

- an estimated \$1,000-\$1,500 for travel every time the board meets
- clerical staff for the first year during the rules writing process 1/2 FTE \$25K
- some General Counsel time for crafting of the language
- first year 2 meetings/month and rule writing \$20K in travel and \$25K in admin cost
- admin staff to gather, process and produce information for the board

-Total estimated impact \$50K-\$60K
