**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute for the measure allows the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission to sell real estate and personal property owned by the State of Oklahoma or the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department under the jurisdiction of the Commission and in Delaware County and Honey Creek State Park. The sale will be subject to all existing easements and reservations of record. The Commission or Department may transfer any interests such as licenses, operating permits and leasehold interests to a subsequent purchaser. Any monies from the sale, except those to pay expenses related to the sale, will be deposited into the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department Revolving Fund 215. Revenue derived from the sale and deposited in the fund is to be used for the benefit for the state park system.
