Fiscal Analysis

FA1 for HB 1952 limits Corporation Commission motor vehicle enforcement actions to within 7 miles of a weigh station. Officials at the Corporation Commission state that the measure could have an estimated \$1.6 million impact in 2014, the act's effective date. Another portion of the impact, according to Commission officials, is that enforcement employees in sectors of the state that have no working or upgraded weigh stations may lose employment, only to have the Commission need to hire new employees and train them when weigh stations come online in that sector of the state.
