**Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 1952 separates and clarifies the duties of the Corporation Commission with regard to size and weight enforcement. The measure establishes that Corporation Commission employees are authorized to enforce size and weight requirements at stationary and permanent scale facilities. The measure repeal 47 O.S. Section 172.1 relating to the qualifications for enforcement officers.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1952 restricts the Corporation Commission's motor vehicle enforcement duties to permanent weigh stations. According to officials at the Commission, the fiscal impact of the measure, as written, would be around \$1 million in lost fines and penalties. More specific fiscal information is still being developed by the Commission.
