Research Analysis

HB 2259, as introduced, modifies the definition of persons employed in private homes for the purpose of being exempt from the Workers' Compensation Code. The measure provides that *residential employees*, instead of *domestic servants* or *casual workers*, will mean any worker employed by the employer for less than 52 hours during 90 days immediately preceding the date of injury, or who earned less than \$100 in wages during those 90 days.

Currently, the exemption applies to those employees where the private home or household has a gross annual payroll in the preceding calendar year of less than \$10,000.
