Research Analysis

The introduced version of House Bill 2341 extends for two more years, until June 30, 2014, the timeframe for which school districts will not lose accreditation for not meeting media materials, equipment and expenditure standards. The measure instructs the State Textbook Committee to suspend textbook adoption for two years and allows school districts to suspend local textbook committees and textbook adoptions until June 30, 2014. The measure also allows districts to spend textbook money for other purposes for two more years.
