Research Analysis

The Conference Committee Report for HB 2646 rejects the Senate Amendment to strike Title reverting the bill to the Engrossed version of the measure.

HB 2645 imposes a continuing education requirement for members of county excise boards. The measure stipulates that a member must complete six hours of relevant instruction within 18 months of appointment for the first 4 years of service and 3 hours of instruction for every 4 years of service after the expiration of the initial 4 year period. The relevant course must be offered or approved by the Oklahoma State University Cooperative Extension Service.

Fiscal Analysis

The continuing education requirements are required of the members of a county excise board. The provisions do not include whether the board member or the county will pay any costs associated with the continuing education. Officials with an organization representing counties indicate the costs are expected to be minimal.
