**Research Analysis**

Floor amendment No. 1 to House Bill 3130 requires charter schools to file a report with the State Department of Education when contracting with a person to work as a teacher when that person is lawfully present in the United States under a nonimmigrant temporary worker visa. The report must show proof that the charter school made efforts to employ people who are residents of the United States, that there is a shortage of persons who are qualified for the position and are residents of Oklahoma or the United States. The amendment also prohibits the renewal of charter school contracts if schools have been identified for school improvement by the State Board of Education for three or more consecutive years.
