**Research Analysis**

SB 1733 would allow a carry concealed permit holder to carry a firearm into any state courthouse, including the State Capitol Building or other structures in the State Capitol Complex in which courtrooms or judicial offices are maintained if the person's name appears on a list maintained by the Administrative Director of the Courts. Provides that the Self Defense Act license grants the authority of the holder to carry a handgun concealed or unconcealed.
