**Research Analysis**

Amendment No. 1 to floor amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill 264 requires that people be certified or licensed by the State Board of Education before a district can hire them as teachers, counselors, librarians, school nurses, superintendents, principals, supervisors or any other instructional, supervisory or administrative employee. The measure would not apply to those exempt from certification or licensure requirements.
