Research Analysis

The conference committee substitute to Senate Bill 435 requires that upon assuming office, the governor must appoint one member from each congressional district and one member from the state at-large to serve on the State Board of Education. The state superintendent of public instruction will be the seventh member of the board.

Each appointment will be effective April 2 and terms will be four years. Members will serve until the governor appoints a successor and members will serve at the pleasure of the governor. Appointments are contingent upon Senate approval.

Appointed positions of the current board will be deemed vacant when the measure becomes effective. Terms of the newly appointed members will end April 2, 2015, and then every four years thereafter.
