Research Analysis

The committee substitute to Senate Bill 435 provides that governor will appoint one member from each congressional district and one member from the state at-large to the seven-member State Board of Education. Terms will be four years and each member will serve at the pleasure of the governor. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction will serve as the seventh member and chairperson of the board.

The terms of the members serving on the State Board of Education at the time of the effective date of the measure will be terminated on July 1, 2011. The governor must make new appointments by August 1, 2011, and they will be subject to Senate approval.

Thereafter, the governor may fill vacancies subject to confirmation by the Senate at the next session of the Legislature.
