**Research Analysis**

The measure alters the composition of the State Board of Education to four members who are the state superintendent of public instruction, the governor, secretary of state and attorney general or their designees. The board must meet once each quarter and the superintendent of public instruction or a majority of the members can call a special meeting. The superintendent of public instruction will have control of all of the divisions of the State Department of Education while the board will supervise instruction in the public school system. The superintendent must submit a departmental budget to the governor and school districts must submit their budget needs with the superintendent.
