12 An Act relating to personal identification; requiring  
13 the Department of Public Safety to provide space for  
certain emblem on driver licenses and identification  
14 cards; requiring presentation of certain documents;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
15 effective date.

16  
17 BE IN ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-124 of Title 47, unless there  
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 As a way to honor and recognize the veterans who have served our  
22 country, the Department of Public Safety shall make space available  
23 in the upper left hand corner of the front of the driver license and  
24 the identification card for a flag emblem and the word "veteran" to

1 be designed by the Department that will serve as a notation of  
2 veteran status. Upon application for issuance or renewal of the  
3 driver license or identification card and in addition to other  
4 documentation required by the Department, persons requesting the  
5 flag emblem shall show proof of present or past military service by  
6 presenting:

7 1. A valid Uniformed Services Identity Card;

8 2. A United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214, (DD)215

9 or a World War II discharge document WD AGO Form or NavPers Form  
10 that shows a discharge status of "honorable" or "general under  
11 honorable conditions"; or

12 3. A United States Department of Veterans Affairs photo

13 identification card.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
