Section 1: the CCS changes the obligation amount from \$160 million to \$120 million. The measure also changes the final maturity date from 30 to 10 years. The measure creates the State Capitol Repair Expenditure Oversight Committee. The committee is tasked with preparing and approving a project programming plan for the repair of the State Capitol.
