- C. In addition, any person violating subsection A or B of this section using a dangerous or deadly weapon shall be guilty of a felony, and shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not more than twenty (20) years, or fined by a fine of not more than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- D. No person, other than an authorized law enforcement officer or person in possession of a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, shall board a bus public transportation with a dangerous or deadly weapon concealed upon or about his or her person. Upon the discovery of any such item or material, the company a public transportation official may obtain possession and retain custody of such item or material until it is transferred to the custody of law enforcement officers.
