20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
21	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified			
22	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 291 of Title 17, unless there is			
23	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:			
24	As used in this act:			

1. "Commission" means the Corporation Commission;

- 2. "Electric transmission facility" means a high-voltage transmission line with a rating of sixty-nine (69) kilovolts or above, including related transmission facilities and controls;
- 3. "Incumbent electric transmission owner" means any Oklahoma electric public utility, as recognized by the Commission, or its affiliates, any electric cooperative, any municipal power agency or any municipal utility that owns, operates and maintains an electric transmission line in this state;
- 4. "Local electric transmission line" means a high-voltage transmission line with a capacity of three hundred (300) kilovolts or less and associated transmission facilities; and
- 5. "Southwest Power Pool" means the Southwest Power Pool or any federally recognized successor entity.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 292 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. An incumbent electric transmission owner has the right to construct, own and maintain a local electric transmission line that has been approved for construction in a Southwest Power Pool transmission plan and will interconnect to facilities owned by that incumbent electric transmission owner. An incumbent electric transmission owner has the right to construct, own and maintain:

- 1. A new electric transmission facility that connects to electric transmission facilities owned by the incumbent; and
- 2. Upgrades to the existing electric transmission facilities of the incumbent.
- B. The right to construct, own and maintain a local electric transmission line that will interconnect to facilities owned by two or more incumbent electric transmission owners belongs individually and equally to each incumbent electric transmission owner, unless otherwise agreed upon in writing.
- C. An incumbent electric transmission owner may contract with a new electric transmission owner proposing to connect an electric transmission facility to the transmission facilities of the incumbent electric transmission owner regarding the responsibility for:
 - 1. Maintenance and upgrades; and
 - 2. Reliability compliance.

- D. Nothing in this section is intended to affect an incumbent electric transmission owner's use and control of its existing property rights. The retention, modification or transfer of existing property rights shall remain subject to the relevant state law or regulation that granted the property right.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 293 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. If the Southwest Power Pool has approved a local electric transmission line in a Southwest Power Pool transmission plan and has formally directed the incumbent electric transmission owner or owners, if there is more than one owner, to construct the local electric transmission line, the incumbent electric transmission owner or owners shall give notice to the Southwest Power Pool, in writing, within ninety (90) days of receipt of the direction to construct by the Southwest Power Pool, regarding its intent to construct, own and maintain the local electric transmission line. If notice is not provided, the incumbent electric transmission owner shall surrender its right to construct, own and maintain the local electric transmission line.

B. If an incumbent electric transmission owner or owners give notice of intent not to build the local electric transmission line or fail to provide notice as required in subsection A of this section, then the Southwest Power Pool may determine whether the incumbent electric transmission owner or owners or other entity will build the local electric transmission line.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
