PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to open meetings; amending 25 O.S.
2011, Section 314, which relates to violations of the
Oklahoma Open Meeting Act; permitting member of
public to bring civil suit for declarative relief for
violation of act; providing for reasonable attorney
fees if successful; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2011, Section 314, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 314. A. Any person or persons willfully violating any
of the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and
upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Five
Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for
a period not exceeding one (1) year or by both such fine and
imprisonment.

1 B. A member of the public may bring a civil suit for
2 declarative relief of a violation of this act. If such suit is
3 successful, the plaintiff shall be entitled to reasonable attorney
4 fees.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
