L8	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

study shall be to determine the reasons why some students in the

state have not been successful in acquiring the appropriate grade
level reading skills, to identify the best practices available to

help students become successful readers and to implement those best

practices in schools statewide. The Department may contract with a

higher education institution or other entity or consultant to assist

in the study, contingent upon the availability of funding.

B. The State Department of Education shall:

- 1. Gather data and complete an assessment of the type of reading instruction practices and methods currently being used by school districts in the state; and
- 2. Gather data on students who have been assessed pursuant to Section 1210.508C of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and have been found not to be reading at the appropriate grade level by the third grade including, but not limited to:
 - a. socioeconomic information,
 - b. access to reading resources outside of school, and
 - c. screening for and identification of learning disabilities.
- C. After gathering and analyzing the data as provided for in this section, the State Department of Education shall issue a report no later than December 31, 2015, to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. In addition to other information and recommendations, the

report shall also include recommendations on legislative changes that need to be made to the third-grade retention requirements in the Reading Sufficiency Act and any other requirements in the act. Any student data contained in the report shall be aggregated D. so that individual students cannot be identified. SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 54-2-9879 KΒ 02/04/14
