PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; providing
exempt treatment for homestead of surviving spouse of
certain persons injured at military facility;
specifying periods of exempt treatment; providing for
exempt treatment notwithstanding provisions of
Section 22A of Article X of the Oklahoma
Constitution; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2902.5 of Title 68, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Despite any provision to the contrary, for assessment years
beginning on or after January 1, 2009, the surviving spouse of a
person killed during an act of violence occurring within a federal
military installation, which could have been classified as
"terrorism" or "combat related" by the President of the United

1 States or any department of the United States military shall be
2 entitled to claim an exemption for the full amount of the fair cash
3 value of the homestead for all assessment years beginning January 1,
4 2009, through December 31, 2014, and for each assessment year
5 thereafter.

6 B. In order to be eligible for the exemption authorized by this
7 section, the surviving spouse shall be required to prove residency
8 within the State of Oklahoma and must have previously qualified for
9 the homestead exemption authorized by law or be eligible for the
10 homestead exemption pursuant to law.

11 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall be
12 enforced notwithstanding the provisions of Section 22A of Article X
13 of the Oklahoma Constitution.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2015.
