PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to firearms; authorizing certain persons to bypass security check points at the State Capitol; construing certain provision; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1290.27 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person with a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or valid handgun license issued from another state, when entering the State Capitol building through a security checkpoint, shall be authorized to bypass the security checkpoint upon presenting the valid handgun license.

Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize a law enforcement officer to remove or inspect any weapon or restrain any

1 person carrying a properly concealed handgun without probable cause  
2 that a crime has been committed.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
