8 An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
9 amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.4, which relates  
10 to training programs for county officers; authorizing  
11 Cooperative Extension Service to establish  
12 examination and accreditation system for certain  
13 persons; authorizing fee for training and  
14 accreditation; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.4, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 130.4 A. The Cooperative Extension Service is hereby  
19 authorized to create advisory boards as they deem necessary.  
20 Members of such advisory boards shall be appointed by the  
21 Cooperative Extension Service and shall include, but shall not be  
22 limited to, county government officials and appropriate state agency  
23 representatives. Meetings of advisory boards shall be called by the  
24 County Training Program Director of the Cooperative Extension  
Service. Such advisory boards shall assist in developing

1 educational programs and materials for training county government  
2 officers and their employees.

3 Advisory board members shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred  
4 in the performance of their duties under Sections 130.1 through  
5 130.7 of this title in accordance with the State Travel  
6 Reimbursement Act.

7 B. The Cooperative Extension Service is authorized to contract  
8 with state agencies and private entities to provide training.

9 C. The Cooperative Extension Service is authorized to:

10 1. Establish and maintain a procedure or system for the  
11 examination and accreditation of county officers, candidates for  
12 county office or any other person;

13 2. Establish a registration system and adopt and enforce  
14 standards for the training, examination and accreditation of county  
15 officers, candidates for county office, or any other person; and

16 3. Charge a fee, not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00),  
17 to any person seeking training and accreditation from the  
18 Cooperative Extension Service.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
