15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.4, is		
16	amended to read as follows:		
17	Section 130.4 A. The Cooperative Extension Service is hereby		
18	authorized to create advisory boards as they deem necessary.		
19	Members of such advisory boards shall be appointed by the		
20	Cooperative Extension Service and shall include, but shall not be		
21	limited to, county government officials and appropriate state agency		
22	representatives. Meetings of advisory boards shall be called by the		
23	County Training Program Director of the Cooperative Extension		
24	Service. Such advisory boards shall assist in developing

1 educational programs and materials for training county government 2 officers and their employees.

Advisory board members shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties under Sections 130.1 through 130.7 of this title in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

- B. The Cooperative Extension Service is authorized to contract with state agencies and private entities to provide training.
 - C. The Cooperative Extension Service is authorized to:
- 1. Establish and maintain a procedure or system for the examination and accreditation of county officers, candidates for county office or any other person;
- 2. Establish a registration system and adopt and enforce standards for the training, examination and accreditation of county officers, candidates for county office, or any other person; and
- 3. Charge a fee, not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00),
 to any person seeking training and accreditation from the

 Cooperative Extension Service.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
