17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,		
18	the following proposed amendment to Section 26 of Article II of the		
19	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:		
20	Section 26. The $\underline{\text{fundamental}}$ right of $\frac{1}{2}$ $\underline{\text{each individual}}$ citizen		
21	to keep and to bear arms in including, but not limited to, handguns,		
22	rifles, shotguns, knives and other common weapons, ammunition and		
23	the components thereof, for security, defense of his home, person,		
24	or property, or in aid of the civil power, when thereunto legally

2	purpose shall never be prohibited; but nothing herein contained
