- B. If the candidate has ever pled guilty or nolo contendere to,

 or been convicted of, a felony, or at the time of filing the

 Declaration of Candidacy is named in an outstanding warrant for

 arrest, in this or any other state, the candidate shall provide the

 following information on a form prescribed by the Secretary of the

 State Election Board:
 - 1. The name of the offense;

C. A Declaration of Candidacy form must be signed by the candidate, and the signature must be properly notarized by a notary public or other person authorized by law to administer oaths. D. In addition to the information required by this section, a candidate may include a telephone number, email e-mail address and website address. Such additional information shall not be required of any candidate but if provided shall be made available to the public. SECTION 2.
