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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:						
20	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2011, Section 1085.1, is						
21	amended to read as follows:						
22	Section 1085.1 A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Water						
23	Resources Board, hereinafter referred to as the Board, consisting of						
24	nine (9) members to be appointed by the Governor, by and with the						

advice and consent of the Senate. The Board shall constitute a body corporate and politic and an instrumentality, agency and department of the State of Oklahoma, and exercise by the Board of the powers conferred by this act shall be deemed and shall be held to be an essential governmental function of the State of Oklahoma. One member shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year; one member shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years; one member shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years; one member shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years; one member shall be appointed for a term of five (5) years; two members shall be appointed for a term of six (6) years; and two members shall be appointed for a term of seven (7) years. Upon the expiration of said terms, their successors shall be appointed for terms of seven (7) years. One member shall be appointed from each of the congressional districts of this state and the remaining members shall be appointed at large. However, when congressional districts are redrawn then each member appointed prior to July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall complete the current term of office and appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be based on the redrawn districts. Appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be from any redrawn districts which are not represented by a Board member until

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such time as each of the modified congressional districts are represented by a Board member.

- B. Beginning with the expiration of the at-large member

  position in 2013, the membership of the Board shall transition from

  congressional district and at-large representation to regional

  representation as follows:
- 1. The at-large member position expiring in 2013 shall thereafter be represented by a person residing in the North Central Region of the state which shall consist of Garfield, Grant, Kay, Kingfisher, Lincoln, Logan, Noble, Pawnee and Payne counties;
- 2. The Congressional District 1 position expiring in 2014 shall thereafter be represented by a person residing in the Southeast

  Region of the state which shall consist of Atoka, Bryan, Choctaw,

  Coal, Johnston, McCurtain, Murray, Pontotoc and Pushmataha counties;
- 3. The at-large member position expiring in 2014 shall thereafter be represented by a person residing in the South Central Region of the state which shall consist of Carter, Garvin, Grady, Jefferson, Love, Marshall and Stephens counties;
- 4. The Congressional District 2 position expiring in 2015 shall thereafter be represented by a person residing in the East Central Region of the state which shall consist of Haskell, Hughes, Latimer, LeFlore, McIntosh, Okfuskee, Pittsburg, Seminole and Sequoyah counties;

5. The at-large position expiring in 2016 shall thereafter be
represented by a person residing in the Northeast Region of the
state which shall consist of Adair, Cherokee, Craig, Creek,

Delaware, Mayes, Muskogee, Nowata, Okmulgee, Osage, Ottawa, Rogers,

Tulsa, Wagoner and Washington counties;

6. The Congressional District 4 position expiring in 2017 shall thereafter be represented by a person residing in the Panhandle Region of the state which shall consist of Beaver, Cimarron and Texas counties;

- 7. The Congressional District 5 position expiring in 2018 shall thereafter be represented by a person residing in the Central Region of the state which shall consist of Canadian, Cleveland, McClain,

  Oklahoma and Pottawatomie counties;
- 8. The at-large position expiring in 2018 shall represent the

  Southwest Region of the state which shall consist of Beckham, Caddo,

  Comanche, Cotton, Custer, Greer, Harmon, Jackson, Kiowa, Roger

  Mills, Tillman and Washita counties; and
- 9. The Congressional District 3 position expiring in 2019 shall thereafter be represented by a person residing in the Northwest

  Region of the state which shall consist of Alfalfa, Blaine, Dewey,

  Ellis, Harper, Major, Woods and Woodward counties.
- 22 <u>C. All members appointed after the effective date of this act</u>
  23 <u>shall be appointed for terms of seven (7) years.</u>

D. If a member serving on the Board as of the effective date of this act resigns or is unable to complete the term of the member, the seat shall immediately transition to the applicable regional representation as provided for in subsection B of this section.

E. Each member shall be a qualified elector of this state. At all times the membership of the Board shall have represented on it at least one member well versed in each of the following major types of water use: recreational, industrial, irrigational, municipal, rural residential, agricultural and, soil conservation work and oil and gas production. Not more than two members may be selected representing any one of the major types of water use. The Board shall meet at least once each month. The members of the Board may be removed only for cause. Whenever a vacancy shall occur, the Governor shall appoint a qualified person to fill the unexpired term of the vacant office. Each member of the Board upon entering upon his the duties of the member shall take and subscribe to the constitutional and statutory oath of office and file the same with the Secretary of State.

B. F. The Board shall organize annually by electing a chairman chair, vice-chairman vice chair, and secretary from the membership of the Board, who shall perform such duties as shall be prescribed by the Board.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

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declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
