16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
1,7	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Public Agency
19	Fee Moratorium Justification and Disclosure Act of 2013".
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10.7 of Title 74, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. Unless otherwise provided by law, a moratorium is hereby
24	established on all agencies, prohibiting any agency from creating

- any new fees or increasing any current fees. The moratorium shall be in effect until January 1, 2016.
 - B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not apply to a fee increase if:
 - 1. It does not exceed the increase, if any, for inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index-All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) each year as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics;
 - 2. The change in fee is required to comply with federal law;
 - 3. The fee is for an activity or service which the consumer elects voluntarily and has other alternatives from which to choose; or
 - 4. The fee results as a consequence of violating the law.
- C. Any fees charged by an agency, at the time of payment, shall provide a fee justification statement which shall disclose and describe in detail to the entity paying the fee the reason for the fee charged.
 - D. For purposes of this section, "agency" includes but is not limited to any statutorily created state board, bureau, commission, office or authority, and any constitutional entities not charged with self governance.
- 21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
