COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to schools; creating the Oklahoma Extracurricular Activities Accountability Act; providing definition; prohibiting school districts from being a member of a school athletic association unless certain requirements are met; requiring compliance with the Oklahoma Open Records and Oklahoma Open Meeting Acts; requiring certain audits; and providing for codification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-101 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Extracurricular Activities Accountability Act".

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-102 of Title 70, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 As used in the Oklahoma Extracurricular Activities
5 Accountability Act, a "school athletic association" means any
6 private organization or association which charges the school or
7 school district a membership fee, retains a portion of revenue
8 generated by the interscholastic activities or contests of the
9 member schools, and provides the coordination, supervision and
10 regulation of the interscholastic activities and contests of the
11 member schools.

12 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-103 of Title 70, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A public school or school district shall not be a member of any
16 school athletic association unless that association has adopted a
17 written policy that requires the following:

18 1. All records of the association to be made accessible
19 consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act;

20 2. All meetings of the association to be open and conducted in
21 a manner consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting
22 Act, including specifically the notice and agenda, voting and
23 executive session requirements; and

1 3. An annual financial audit and a compliance audit of all
2 funds of the association in accordance with the auditing standards
3 set forth in the Oklahoma Public School Audit Law. In addition, the
4 association shall have performance audits conducted of the
5 operations of the association. A performance audit shall be
6 conducted no later than December 31, 2014, and by December 31 every
7 five (5) years thereafter.

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
