9 shall deem certain individuals ineligible to receive
10 certain benefits; providing for noncodification; and
11 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 Pursuant to the authorization given to the states under 7 U.S.C.
17 214(j), the state shall deem ineligible any individual previously
18 deemed automatically eligible under this statute who maintains over
19 Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) in "liquid resources" as defined
20 below:

- 21 1. Cash on hand;
- 22 2. Checking or savings account balances;
- 23 3. The cash value of savings certificates; and
- 24 4. The cash value of stocks or bonds.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.

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
