17	Each school district board of education may adopt a zero
18	tolerance policy for the school district which requires application
19	of and enforcement of a mandatory punishment, discipline or
20	reprimand for specific offenses.
21	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.
22	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
