13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1290.27 of Title 21, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	Any person with a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the
17	provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or valid handgun license
18	issued from another state, and upon notifying security checkpoint
19	officials, shall be allowed to enter the State Capitol building with
20	a handgun. The person shall be subject to search for any other
21	unauthorized contraband or weapons.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
