COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to firearms; authorizing certain persons to enter the State Capitol with a handgun; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1290.27 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person with a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or valid handgun license issued from another state, and upon notifying security checkpoint officials, shall be allowed to enter the State Capitol building with a handgun. The person shall be subject to search for any other unauthorized contraband or weapons.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
