9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to state parks; establishing
11 requirements for certain boat rental businesses
12 operating in state parks; providing penalty for
13 certain violations; defining term; providing for
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2217.1 of Title 74, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Any boat rental business operating in a state park:

20 1. Shall have a current valid written contract with the
21 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department or the agency which owns
22 the lake;

23 2. Shall be required to obtain a business license from the
24 state;

1 3. Shall have a visible, commercially accessible public
2 location; and

3 4. Shall be properly licensed with a tax permit and any other
4 required local permits.

5 B. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this
6 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to
7 exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the
8 county jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days or by both
9 such fine and imprisonment.

10 C. As used in this section, "boat rental business" means a
11 short-term lease or rental of any boat, including the completion of
12 paperwork or documents, and the loading and delivery of the boat.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
