13	the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to forms for Declarations of Candidacy; requiring certain
14	candidates to provide certain information; providing exception; and providing an effective date.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 5-111, as
19	last amended by Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1741 of the 1st
20	Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
21	follows:
22	Section 5-111. A. Forms to be used for filing Declarations of
23	Candidacy shall be prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election
24	Board and shall contain the following information:

- 7 <u>6. The</u> party affiliation of <u>the</u> candidate seeking political 8 party nomination;
  - 7. The precinct and county wherein the candidate is a registered voter;  $\frac{1}{2}$
- 8. An oath wherein the candidate swears or affirms that he or she is qualified to become a candidate for the office sought, and that, if elected, the candidate will be qualified to hold the office; and any
  - 9. Any additional information which the Secretary deems necessary.
  - B. If the candidate has ever been ultimately determined by a court of proper authority to be guilty of an offense specified in subsection A of Section 5-105a of this title or at the time of filing the Declaration of Candidacy is named in an outstanding warrant for arrest for such an offense, in this or any other state, the candidate shall provide the following information on a form prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election Board:

1. The name of the offense;

1	2. The date of conviction or issuance of the outstanding
2	warrant; and
3	3. The county and state of conviction or issuance of the
4	outstanding warrant.
5	The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to an offense
6	for which the candidate has received a pardon.
7	$\underline{\text{C.}}$ A Declaration of Candidacy form must be signed by the
8	candidate, and the signature must be properly notarized by a notary
9	public or other person authorized by law to administer oaths.
10	$\underline{\mathtt{D.}}$ In addition to the information required by this section, a
11	candidate may include a telephone number, email address and website
12	address. Such additional information shall not be required of any
13	candidate but if provided shall be made available to the public.
14	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
