6 An Act relating to change of name; amending 12 O.S.
7 2011, Section 1631, which relates to the right to
8 petition for a change of name; prohibiting certain
persons from petitioning; and providing an effective
date.

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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 12 O.S. 2011, Section 1631, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1631. Any natural person, who has been domiciled in
15 this state or who has been residing upon any military reservation
16 located in said state, for more than thirty (30) days, and has been
17 an actual resident of the county or such military reservation
18 situated in said county, or county in which the military reservation
19 is situated, for more than thirty (30) days, next preceding the
20 filing of the action, may petition for a change of name in a civil
21 action in the district court; provided, no person who is required to
22 register as a sex offender pursuant to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders
23 Registration Act may petition for a change of name. If the person
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1 be a minor, the action may be brought by guardian or next friend as
2 in other actions.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
