10	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2011, Section 314, is

13	of the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and
14	upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Five
15	Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for
16	a period not exceeding one (1) year or by both such fine and

18	B. Following a violation of this act, any person:
19	1. May bring a civil suit for declarative or injunctive relief,

21	2. If successful, shall be entitled to reasonable attorney
