Any person who fails to obtain a license as required in subsection A of this section and pay the fee as required in paragraph 1 of subsection $\frac{C}{C}$ D of this section, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed six (6) months, or by both said fine and imprisonment.
- E. F.
