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7 An Act relating to the Judicial Nominating
8 Commission; modifying appointing authority for
9 certain commissioners; specifying requirements for
10 certain commissioners; providing for filling of
11 certain vacancies; terminating certain terms;
12 directing certain appointments; providing for
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1671 of Title 20, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. As authorized pursuant to paragraph 2 of subsection A of
19 Section 3 of Article VII-B of the Oklahoma Constitution, three
20 attorney members of the Judicial Nominating Commission shall be
21 appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and three
22 attorney members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
23 Representatives. The six attorney members of the Judicial
24 Nominating Commission shall be members of the Oklahoma Bar
Association, and shall include at least one appointee from each

1 congressional district. Vacancies of any lawyer commissioner shall
2 be filled by the original appointing authority under this section.

3 B. On the effective date of this act, all appointed attorney
4 member positions of the current Judicial Nominating Commission shall
5 be deemed vacant and the terms of such members serving on the
6 Commission shall be deemed terminated. The President Pro Tempore of
7 the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
8 make initial appointments for attorney members of the Commission
9 pursuant to subsection A of this section within thirty (30) days of
10 the effective date of this act.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
