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8 An Act relating to public assistance; prohibiting use
9 of electronic benefit transfer cards at certain
10 establishments; providing definitions; directing the
11 Oklahoma Department of Human Services to provide
certain information to the Legislature; providing for
codification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 241.4 of Title 56, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. No debit or electronic benefit transfer cards that contain
19 state or federal funds from programs including, but not limited to,
20 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) may be used in any
21 transaction in:

22 1. Any liquor store;

23 2. Any casino, gambling casino, or gaming establishment; or
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1 3. Any retail establishment which provides adult-oriented
2 entertainment in which performers disrobe or perform in an unclothed
3 state for entertainment.

4 B. For the purposes of this act:

5 1. "Liquor store" means any retail establishment that sells
6 exclusively or primarily intoxicating liquor but does not include a
7 grocery store that sells both intoxicating liquor and groceries;

8 2. "Casino", "gambling casino", and "gaming establishment" do
9 not include:

10 a. a grocery store that sells groceries and that also
11 offers, or is located within the same building or
12 complex as an establishment that offers casino,
13 gambling, or gaming activities, or

14 b. any other establishment that offers casino, gambling,
15 or gaming activities incidental to the principal
16 purpose of the business; and

17 3. "Electronic benefit transfer transaction" means the use of a
18 credit or debit card service, automated teller machine, point-of-
19 sale terminal, or access to an online system for the withdrawal of
20 funds or the processing of a payment for merchandise or service.

21 C. By August 1, 2013, the Oklahoma Department of Human Services
22 shall report on the status of an implementation plan pursuant to the
23 provisions of this section. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate
24 and Speaker of the House of Representatives shall be provided with

1 updates on the status of implementation on a quarterly basis until
2 provisions of this section are fully implemented by the Department.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
