12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:	
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1903,	is
14	amended to read as follows:	
15	Section 1903. A. No person shall by force or violence,	or
16	threat of force or violence, seize or exercise control of any	bus
17	public transportation. Any person violating this subsection	shall
18	be guilty of a felony, and shall, upon conviction, be $\frac{impriso}{i}$	ned
19	punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of	
20	Corrections for not more than twenty (20) years, or fined by	a fine
21	of not more than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by	both
22	such fine and imprisonment.	
23	B. In addition, no person shall intimidate, threaten, as	sault
24	or batter any driver, attendant, guard or passenger of any $\frac{1}{2}$	S

- public transportation with intent to violate subsection A of this
  section. Any person violating this subsection shall be guilty of a

  felony, and shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned punished by

  imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not

  more than ten (10) years, or fined by a fine of not more than Five

  Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
  - C. In addition, any person violating subsection A or B of this section using a dangerous or deadly weapon shall be guilty of a felony, and shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not more than twenty (20) years, or fined by a fine of not more than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
  - D. No person, other than an authorized law enforcement officer or person in possession of a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, shall board a bus public transportation with a dangerous or deadly weapon concealed upon or about his or her person. Upon the discovery of any such item or material, the company a public transportation official may obtain possession and retain custody of such item or material until it is transferred to the custody of law enforcement officers. Any person convicted of violating this subsection shall be guilty of a felony, and shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of

1	<u>Corrections</u> for not more than ten (10) years, or <del>fined</del> by a fine of
2	not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or by both such
3	fine and imprisonment.
4	E. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm
5	or hurl or place in the path any missile at, into or within any bus,
6	in a public transportation terminal or other transportation
7	facility. Such person shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony
8	punishable by a fine of not more than Five Thousand Dollars
9	(\$5,000.00), or by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of
10	<u>Corrections</u> for not more than five (5) years, or <u>by</u> both <u>such fine</u>
11	and imprisonment.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
