14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
17	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Public Agency
18	Fee Moratorium Justification and Disclosure Act of 2013".
19	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10.7 of Title 74, unless there
21	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	A. Unless otherwise provided by law, a moratorium is hereby
23	established on all agencies prohibiting any agency from creating any
24	

- 1 new fees or increasing any current fees. The moratorium shall be in 2 effect until January 1, 2016.
 - B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not apply to a fee increase if:
 - 1. It does not exceed the increase, if any, for inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index-All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) each year as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics;
 - 2. The change in fee is required to comply with federal law; or
 - 3. The fee results as a consequence of violating the law.
 - C. Any fees charged by an agency, at the time of payment, shall provide a fee justification statement which shall disclose and describe in detail to the entity paying the fee the reason for the fee charged.
 - D. For purposes of this section, "agency" includes but is not limited to any constitutionally or statutorily created state board, bureau, commission, office or authority.
- SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
