NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-156 of Title 70, unless there 19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 A. A school district may educate students about the history of 21 traditional winter celebrations, and allow students and district 22 staff to offer traditional greetings regarding the celebrations, 23 including: 24 1. Merry Christmas;

1	2. Happy Hanukkah; and
2	3. Happy holidays.
3	B. Except as provided by subsection C of this section, a school
4	district may display on school property scenes or symbols associated
5	with traditional winter celebrations, including a menorah or a
6	Christmas image such as a nativity scene or Christmas tree, if the
7	display includes a scene or symbol of:
8	1. More than one religion; or
9	2. One religion and at least one secular scene or symbol.
10	C. A display relating to a traditional winter celebration shall
11	not include a message that endorses, favors, disfavors or encourages
12	adherence to a particular religious or nonreligious faith, belief or
13	perspective.
14	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2014.
