A. All contracts for the sale or furnishing of 16 water from a source obtained by or on behalf of a municipality by 17 permit or prior right under state law or by general obligation bonds 18 shall be made in the name of the municipality as provided for by 19 statute or by charter. 20 All such water sold and furnished to persons or public or 21 private entities outside the corporate limits of the municipality 22 shall be sold and furnished upon written contracts which shall 23 provide for be subject to an annual review of the municipality's

2	appropriate. Any modification of rates shall be nondiscriminatorily
3	allocated between the municipality's customers and the outside
4	purchaser. Provided, however, that only those costs that are

7	purchaser's rates the outside purchasers shall be responsible to the
8	same extent as the municipality's customers for sharing the costs of
9	the municipality's entire water system, and the outside purchasers'
10	rates may include costs for capital improvements to the water system
11	not otherwise shared by outside purchasers with municipality's
12	customers that pay taxes of the municipality.
13	The contracts shall provide that the persons or public or
14	private entities outside the corporate limits of the municipality
15	shall be subject to a rationing program consistent with any
16	rationing program ordered by the municipality.
17	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
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
