7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
8 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.14, as last amended by  
9 Section 1, Chapter 139, O.S.L. 2013 (21 O.S. Supp.  
10 2013, Section 1290.14), which relates to the Oklahoma  
11 Self-Defense Act; making completion certificates  
12 valid for certain period of time; requiring firearms  
13 instructors to retain records for certain period of  
14 time; authorizing the destruction of certain records;  
15 and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.14, as  
18 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 139, O.S.L. 2013 (21 O.S. Supp.  
19 2013, Section 1290.14), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1290.14

21 SAFETY AND TRAINING COURSE

22 A. Each applicant for a license to carry a concealed or  
23 unconcealed handgun pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act must  
24 successfully complete a firearms safety and training course in this  
state conducted by a registered and approved firearms instructor as  
provided by the provisions of this section. The applicant must

1 further demonstrate competence and qualification with an authorized  
2 pistol of the type or types that the applicant desires to carry as a  
3 concealed or unconcealed handgun pursuant to the provisions of the  
4 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, except certain persons may be exempt from  
5 such training requirement as provided by the provisions of Section  
6 1290.15 of this title.

7 B. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training  
8 (CLEET) shall establish criteria for approving firearms instructors  
9 for purposes of training and qualifying individuals for a handgun  
10 license pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.  
11 Prior to submitting an application for CLEET approval as a firearms  
12 instructor, applicants shall attend a firearms instructor school,  
13 meeting the following minimum requirements:

14 1. Firearms instructor training conducted by one of the  
15 following entities:

- 16 a. Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training,
- 17 b. National Rifle Association,
- 18 c. Oklahoma Rifle Association,
- 19 d. federal law enforcement agencies, or
- 20 e. other professionally recognized organizations;

21 2. The course shall be at least sixteen (16) hours in length;

22 3. Upon completion of the course, the applicant shall be  
23 qualified to provide instruction on revolvers, semiautomatic  
24 pistols, or both; and

1       4. Receive a course completion certificate.

2       All firearms instructors shall be required to meet the  
3 eligibility requirements for a handgun license as provided in  
4 Sections 1290.9, 1290.10, and 1290.11 of this title, and the  
5 application shall be processed as provided for applicants in Section  
6 1290.12 of this title, including the state and national criminal  
7 history records search and fingerprint search. A firearms  
8 instructor shall be required to pay a fee of One Hundred Dollars  
9 (\$100.00) to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training  
10 (CLEET) each time the person makes application for CLEET approval as  
11 a firearms instructor pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma  
12 Self-Defense Act. The fee shall be retained by CLEET and shall be  
13 deposited into the Firearms Instructors Revolving Fund. CLEET shall  
14 promulgate the rules, forms and procedures necessary to implement  
15 the approval of firearms instructors as authorized by the provisions  
16 of this subsection. CLEET shall periodically review each approved  
17 instructor during a training and qualification course to assure  
18 compliance with the rules and course contents. Any violation of the  
19 rules may result in the revocation or suspension of CLEET and  
20 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation approval. Unless the  
21 approval has been revoked or suspended, a firearms instructor's  
22 CLEET approval shall be for a term of five (5) years. Beginning on  
23 July 1, 2003, any firearms instructor who has been issued a four-  
24 year CLEET approval shall not be eligible for the five-year approval

1 until the expiration of the approval previously issued. CLEET shall  
2 be responsible for notifying all approved firearms instructors of  
3 statutory and policy changes related to the Oklahoma Self-Defense  
4 Act.

5 C. 1. All firearms instructors approved by CLEET to train and  
6 qualify individuals for a handgun license shall be required to apply  
7 for registration with the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation  
8 after receiving CLEET approval. All firearms instructors teaching  
9 the approved course for a handgun license must display their  
10 registration certificate during each training and qualification  
11 course. Each approved firearms instructor shall complete a  
12 registration form provided by the Bureau and shall pay a  
13 registration fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to the Bureau at  
14 the time of each application for registration, except as provided in  
15 paragraph 2 of this subsection. Registration certificates issued by  
16 the Bureau shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of  
17 issuance. The Bureau shall issue a five-year handgun license to an  
18 approved firearms instructor at the time of issuance of a  
19 registration certificate and no additional fee shall be required or  
20 charged. The Bureau shall maintain a current listing of all  
21 registered firearms instructors in this state. Nothing in this  
22 paragraph shall be construed to eliminate the requirement for  
23 registration and training with CLEET as provided in subsection B of  
24 this section. Failure to register or be trained as required shall

1 result in a revocation or suspension of the instructor certificate  
2 by the Bureau.

3 2. On or after July 1, 2003, the registered instructors listed  
4 in subparagraphs a and b of this paragraph shall not be required to  
5 renew the firearms instructor registration certificate with the  
6 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation at the expiration of the  
7 registration term, provided the instructor is not subject to any  
8 suspension or revocation of the firearms instructor certificate.

9 The firearms instructor registration with the Oklahoma State Bureau  
10 of Investigation shall automatically renew together with the handgun  
11 license authorized in paragraph 1 of this subsection for an  
12 additional five-year term and no additional cost or fee may be  
13 charged for the following individuals:

14 a. an active duty law enforcement officer of this state  
15 or any of its political subdivisions or of the federal  
16 government who has a valid CLEET approval as a  
17 firearms instructor pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-  
18 Defense Act, and

19 b. a retired law enforcement officer authorized to carry  
20 a firearm pursuant to Section 1289.8 of this title who  
21 has a valid CLEET approval as a firearms instructor  
22 pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.

23 D. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall approve  
24 registration for a firearms instructor applicant who is in full

1 compliance with CLEET rules regarding firearms instructors and the  
2 provisions of subsection B of this section, if completion of the  
3 federal fingerprint search is the only reason for delay of  
4 registration of that firearms instructor applicant. Upon receipt of  
5 the federal fingerprint search information, if the Bureau receives  
6 information which precludes the person from having a handgun  
7 license, the Bureau shall revoke both the registration and the  
8 handgun license previously issued to the firearms instructor.

9 E. The required firearms safety and training course and the  
10 actual demonstration of competency and qualification required of the  
11 applicant shall be designed and conducted in such a manner that the  
12 course can be reasonably completed by the applicant within an eight-  
13 hour period. CLEET shall establish the course content and  
14 promulgate rules, procedures and forms necessary to implement the  
15 provisions of this subsection. For the training and qualification  
16 course, an applicant may be charged a fee that shall be determined  
17 by the instructor conducting the course. The maximum class size  
18 shall be determined by the instructor conducting the course;  
19 provided, however, practice shooting sessions shall not have more  
20 than ten participating students at one time. CLEET may establish  
21 criteria for assistant instructors and any other requirements deemed  
22 necessary to conduct a safe and effective training and qualification  
23 course. The course content shall include a safety inspection of the  
24 firearm to be used by the applicant in the training course;

1 instruction on pistol handling, safety and storage; dynamics of  
2 ammunition and firing; methods or positions for firing a pistol;  
3 information about the criminal provisions of the Oklahoma law  
4 relating to firearms; the requirements of the Oklahoma Self-Defense  
5 Act as it relates to the applicant; self-defense and the use of  
6 appropriate force; a practice shooting session; and a  
7 familiarization course. The firearms instructor shall refuse to  
8 train or qualify any person when the pistol to be used or carried by  
9 the person is either deemed unsafe or unfit for firing or is a  
10 weapon not authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act. The course  
11 shall provide an opportunity for the applicant to qualify himself or  
12 herself on either a derringer, a revolver, a semiautomatic pistol or  
13 any combination of a derringer, a revolver and a semiautomatic  
14 pistol, provided no pistol shall be capable of firing larger than  
15 .45 caliber ammunition. Any applicant who successfully trains and  
16 qualifies himself or herself with a semiautomatic pistol may be  
17 approved by the firearms instructor on the training certificate for  
18 a semiautomatic pistol, a revolver and a derringer upon request of  
19 the applicant. Any person who qualifies on a derringer or revolver  
20 shall not be eligible for a semiautomatic rating until the person  
21 has demonstrated competence and qualifications on a semiautomatic  
22 pistol. Upon successful completion of the training and  
23 qualification course, a certificate shall be issued to each  
24 applicant who successfully completes the course. The certificate of

1 training shall comply with the form established by CLEET and shall  
2 be submitted with an application for a handgun license pursuant to  
3 the provisions of paragraph 2 of subsection A of Section 1290.12 of  
4 this title. The certificate of completion issued to an applicant  
5 shall be valid for a period of three (3) years.

6 F. There is hereby created a revolving fund for the Council on  
7 Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET), to be designated the  
8 "Firearms Instructors Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a  
9 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
10 consist of all funds received for approval of firearms instructors  
11 for purposes of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act. All funds received  
12 shall be deposited to the fund. All monies accruing to the credit  
13 of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and  
14 expended by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training,  
15 for implementation of the training and qualification course  
16 contents, approval of firearms instructors and any other CLEET  
17 requirement pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense  
18 Act or as may otherwise be deemed appropriate by CLEET.  
19 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by  
20 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with  
21 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for  
22 approval and payment.

23 G. Firearms instructors shall keep on file for a period of not  
24 less than three (3) years a roster of each training class, the



1 safety test score of each individual, the caliber and type of weapon  
2 each individual used when qualifying and whether or not each  
3 individual successfully completed the training course. Firearms  
4 instructors shall be authorized to destroy all training documents  
5 and records upon expiration of the three-year time period.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
