12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 593 of Title 21, unless there is
14	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. It shall be unlawful for a CLEET-certified peace officer to
16	request, receive or accept cash payment in the field for any fine,
17	cost, assessment or fee related to a state law violation.
18	B. Any law enforcement officer who violates the provisions of
19	this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor
20	punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one (1)
21	year, or by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or
22	by both such fine and imprisonment.
23	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
