7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
8 21 O.S. 2011, Section 733, which relates to
9 justifiable homicide; clarifying certain provision;
10 defining term; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 733, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 733. A. Homicide is also justifiable when committed by
15 any person in ~~either~~ any of the following cases:

16 1. When resisting any attempt to murder such person, or to
17 commit any felony upon him, or upon or in any dwelling house in
18 which such person is; ~~or,~~

19 2. When committed in the lawful defense of such person, ~~or of~~

20 ~~his or her husband, wife, parent, child, master, mistress, or~~

21 ~~servant~~ another, when there is a reasonable ground to apprehend a

22 ~~design to commit~~ the person using force reasonably believes such

23 force is necessary to prevent death or great bodily harm to himself

24 or herself or another or to terminate or prevent the commission of a

1 ~~forcible felony, or to do some great personal injury, and imminent~~
2 ~~danger of such design being accomplished; or,~~

3 3. When necessarily committed in attempting, by lawful ways and
4 means, to apprehend any person for any felony committed; or in
5 lawfully suppressing any riot; or in lawfully keeping and preserving
6 the peace.

7 B. As used in this section, "forcible felony" means any felony
8 which involves the use or threat of physical force or violence
9 against any person.

10 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
