Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission to the Chickasaw Nation,

government" per the above-referenced statute and which is also an
eligible sponsor for land and water conservation funds under the

THAT, of the real and personal property transferred, all mineral rights shall be retained by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department or the State of Oklahoma.

THAT the real and personal property transfer shall be subject to the authority and requirements in Section 2224 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission, the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and the Governor of the Chickasaw Nation.
