1 "SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.12 of Title 70, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. The State Board of Education shall require, as a condition
5 of accreditation, that public schools provide instruction for
6 students in pre-kindergarten through grade two in social studies for
7 a minimum of an average of thirty (30) minutes per day.

8 B. The State Board of Education shall require, as a condition
9 of accreditation, that public schools provide instruction for
10 students in grades three through six in social studies for a minimum
11 of an average of forty five (45) minutes per day.

12 C. The instruction in social studies as required in this
13 section shall be focused instruction and aligned with the state
14 curriculum standards in social studies for the appropriate grade as
15 adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to Section 11-
16 103.6a of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes."
