a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
A. As used in this section:
1. "Human embryo" means a living organism of the species Homo sapiens
at the earliest stages of development, including the single-celled stage,
that is not located in the body of a female; and
2. "Nontherapeutic research" means research that is not intended to
help preserve the life and health of the particular embryo subjected to

embryo transfer to the body of a female, or any diagnostic test which may assist in the future care of a child subjected to the tests.

- B. No person shall:
- 1. Knowingly conduct nontherapeutic research that destroys a human embryo or subjects a human embryo to substantial risk of injury or death;
- 2. Transfer a human embryo with the knowledge that the embryo will be subjected to nontherapeutic research; or
- 3. Use for research purposes cells or tissues that the person knows were obtained by performing activities in violation of this section.
- C. Any person found violating the provisions of subsection B of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by incarceration in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of not less than one (1) year nor more than life and a fine of not less than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)."
