10	An Act relating to schools; directing the State Department of Education to conduct a study of reading
11	instruction and retention of students; stating purpose of the study; allowing the Department to
12	contract with certain entities; specifying information to be gathered for the study; requiring
13	the Department to issue annual reports by a certain date; specifying the inclusion of certain
14	recommendations; requiring dissemination of best practices; requiring student data to be aggregated;

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.508G of Title 70, unless
21	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	A. The State Department of Education shall conduct a study of

1210.508C of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The purpose of the study shall be to determine the reasons why some students in the state have not been successful in acquiring the appropriate gradelevel reading skills, to identify the best practices available to help students become successful readers and to implement those best practices in schools statewide. The Department may contract with a higher education institution or other entity or consultant to assist in the study, contingent upon the availability of funding.

B. The State Department of Education shall:

- 1. Gather data and complete an assessment of the type of reading instruction practices and methods currently being used by school districts in the state; and
- 2. Gather data on students who have been assessed pursuant to Section 1210.508C of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and have been found not to be reading at the appropriate grade level by the third grade including, but not limited to:
 - a. socioeconomic information,
 - b. access to reading resources outside of school, and
 - c. screening for and identification of learning disabilities.
- 3. For students that score limited knowledge and are not retained by school districts, the study shall address what intensive remediation efforts are being conducted by the district to identify the best practices for these students.

- C. After gathering and analyzing the data as provided for in this section, the State Department of Education shall issue a report no later than December 31, 2015, and each year thereafter, to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. In addition to other information and recommendations, the report shall also include recommendations on legislative changes that need to be made to the third-grade retention requirements in the Reading Sufficiency Act and any other requirements in the act.
- D. Following the issuance of the report required in subsection C of this section, the compilation of best practices shall be disseminated to all public schools.
- E. Any student data contained in the report shall be aggregated so that individual students cannot be identified.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
